Brain Storming, & Discussion	1500Hrs – 1545Hrs	<ul> <li>Participants will learn that the following must be ensured before the broadcast: <ul> <li>The radio is kept at a place from where it is audible to all the children,</li> <li>The radio, battery/ power is checked beforehand.</li> <li>The frequency of the station from where the programme is being broadcast is set beforehand.</li> <li>The sound of the radio should be adjusted beforehand.</li> <li>Doors should be closed to avoid distraction, however the teacher must ensure that there is proper light and children are comfortable in the room.</li> <li>Materials like paper, crayons, etc required for the planned activity must be arranged beforehand.</li> <li>Children should have water; go to the toilet before the broadcast so that there is no disturbance during the 15 minutes broadcast.</li> <li>What the teacher expects from the students during the broadcast should be clear to them before listening to the Meena Radio Programme.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Teachers' Guide Book

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				<ul> <li>Participants will learn that the following should be ensured after the broadcast</li> <li>Children recall of the broadcast content in short.</li> <li>The teacher should ask the children to recall the song as well as the game.</li> <li>Questions should be asked on the story (5 minutes).</li> <li>Discussion should be facilitated on the main message &amp; relevant issues of the story. (7 – 8 minutes).</li> <li>Group activity (song, game, etc) should be facilitated (6 – 7 minutes).</li> <li>Children should be asked, 'which character did you like most and why?'</li> <li>The teacher should discuss day to day real life challenging situations before the children and ask them to find solutions to them.</li> </ul>
