






# Procedures to be followed upon finding a missing child




Responsibilities under Integrated Child Protection Scheme (responsibilities of various government departments)


## Special Juvenile Police Unit


-  Present the child to Child Welfare Committee/Juvenile Justice Board/Children's court
-  Physical and Mental health examination- Social investigation
-  Information to be shared with parents/guardians
-  Filling up form 'M' online
-  Sending report to District Legal Services Authority


 Conducting further enquiry


## Juvenile Justice Board

-  Taking initiative for rehabilitation process
-  Directing Police for crimes committed against the child
-  Ensuring availability of legal aid for the child

 Preparation of Individual Care Plan in uppercase based on Juvenile Justice Act, 2015

 Keeping child at suitable facility/foster care

 Ensuring free legal aid services for the child

 Informing about restoration and further guidance for the child

## Child Welfare Committee

 Giving notice to other related government departments for necessary action
